



ROMANZA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCEDURES 2020

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to each of two graduating Seniors enrolled at St. Johns County Center for the Arts who plan to major in performing arts at the college level.

Eligibility Requirements:

This is a one-time \$1,000 Scholarship.

You must show full-time enrollment at a College or University during the Fall Term 2020.

The applicant must be a 2020 St. Johns County Center of the Arts graduating Senior who plans to pursue post-secondary education in the performing arts. The applicant must also demonstrate the Six Pillars of Character: Trustworthiness, Respect, Responsibility, Fairness, Caring, and Citizenship. The Applicant must have a minimum unweighted overall grade point average of 3.0. Recipients must enroll full time in a post-secondary degree program beginning with the Fall Term of 2020.

Selected scholarship recipients must submit a photograph that may be used for publication about the award.

Application deadline is March 15, 2020. Late submissions will not be considered.

Submit the following documents:

- Completed scholarship application
- Two recommendations from academic teachers
- Submit photo to be used for promotional purposes if you are selected

- Current High School transcript
- Enrollment verification
- Essay
